We write to express our support for the Vermont Agency of Transportation's (VTrans) application for the U.S. Department of Transportation's Bridge Investment Program (CDFA #20.205) for the replacement of the Springfield I-91 Bridge. We are pleased to bring this proposal to your attention.

The Springfield I-91 bridge is a critical structure that facilitates the movement of people and goods in southern Vermont. It serves as the primary highway linking Vermont to northern Massachusetts to the south and Canada to the north, and accounts for the highest volume of regional freight movement from those two major trade hubs. Additionally, it is a critical regional route for residents to access jobs, transit services, and medical services in nearby White River Junction. Finally, this corridor serves as a major gateway to Vermont from southern New England and the Northeast for the region's critical tourism economy. I-91 is Vermont's second most-traveled interstate highway, and therefore it is vital that the Springfield I-91 bridge remains in a state of good repair.

With this grant, VTrans will replace the bridge's decks, performing realignment work, and complete approaches to the bridge. Without this critical work, the bridge risks falling into a state of disrepair due to general deterioration.
